Lane Avenue scheduled for resurfacing at Normandy Boulevard

Jacksonville –Roadway resurfacing is underway on Lane Avenue (State Road 103) between Normandy Boulevard (State Road 228) and Beaver Street (U.S. 90). The resurfacing work is expected to begin Monday, February 27, weather and schedule permitting.

The project improvements also include upgrading handicap accessible ramps along sidewalks and pedestrian signals, repairing sidewalk where necessary, and working on curb and gutter.

Construction operations will be suspended during most special events and holidays. No lane closures will be allowed during the following times Monday through Friday:

- Northbound Lane Avenue from Normandy Boulevard to Beaver Street from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Southbound Lane Avenue from Normandy Boulevard to Beaver Street from 11 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.
- Northbound Lave Avenue from north of Ramona Boulevard to south of the CSX railroad crossing from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m.
- Southbound Lane Avenue from north of Ramona Boulevard to south of the CSX railroad crossing from 4 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Duval Asphalt has been selected to complete the \$1.9 million project by late fall 2017, weather and schedule permitting. Up-to-date information and details on traffic impacts are available at www.northfloridaroads.com.

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) encourages motorists to always follow the 40 mile-per-hour speed limit through the construction zone. Travelers need to be aware of heavy equipment and stay within the limits of the orange cones and barrels.
