Mrs. Leonard was represented by criminal defense attorney Joe East before the Camden County Magistrate Court on Friday at which time, Mr. East informed the Court that Mrs. Leonard intends on entering a "Not Guilty" plea. She was released on an own recognizance bond. Mrs. Leonard is a 62 year old St. Mary's resident with no criminal record. Mr. East plans to vigorously fight these charges. Mrs. Leonard did nothing wrong and we look forward to appearing in Court where both sides of the case will be presented.
