

Duval:

All outdoor activities between 1-4:30 cancelled or moved indoors
All absences will be excused
Dismissal times remain the same (as of now)
Safety advisory will be sent home with students & posted online

St. Johns:

All absences will be excused
Normal dismissal procedures, although you can pick up your child early
Safety info emailed to parents

Baker:

Letter sent home to parents
Middle school dismissal at 11:30
High school dismissal at 11:20 for walkers/car riders, 11:50 for bus riders
Elementary schools dismiss at 4:30 -- district doesn't want younger students traveling or being home unsupervised. Elementary students will not be allowed outside during eclipse.
Absences or early-pickups will be excused

Clay:

Letter sent home to parents
All after-school and athletic activities will be moved indoors from 1-4:15
Regular release hours
Absences will be excused

Nassau:

Secondary schools that have planned eclipse-related activities can proceed, but students will participate on a voluntary basis, and students will have to find own transportation home

Flagler:

Message on website says they want everyone to view it safely, and mentions that middle and high schools will be out by the time of maximum coverage

Columbia:

Normal dismissal procedures will be followed.

Putnam:

Early release day has been approved.

Most elementary schools to be dismissed at 11:20 AM, most middle schools at 12:40 PM, and high schools at 12:30 PM.
