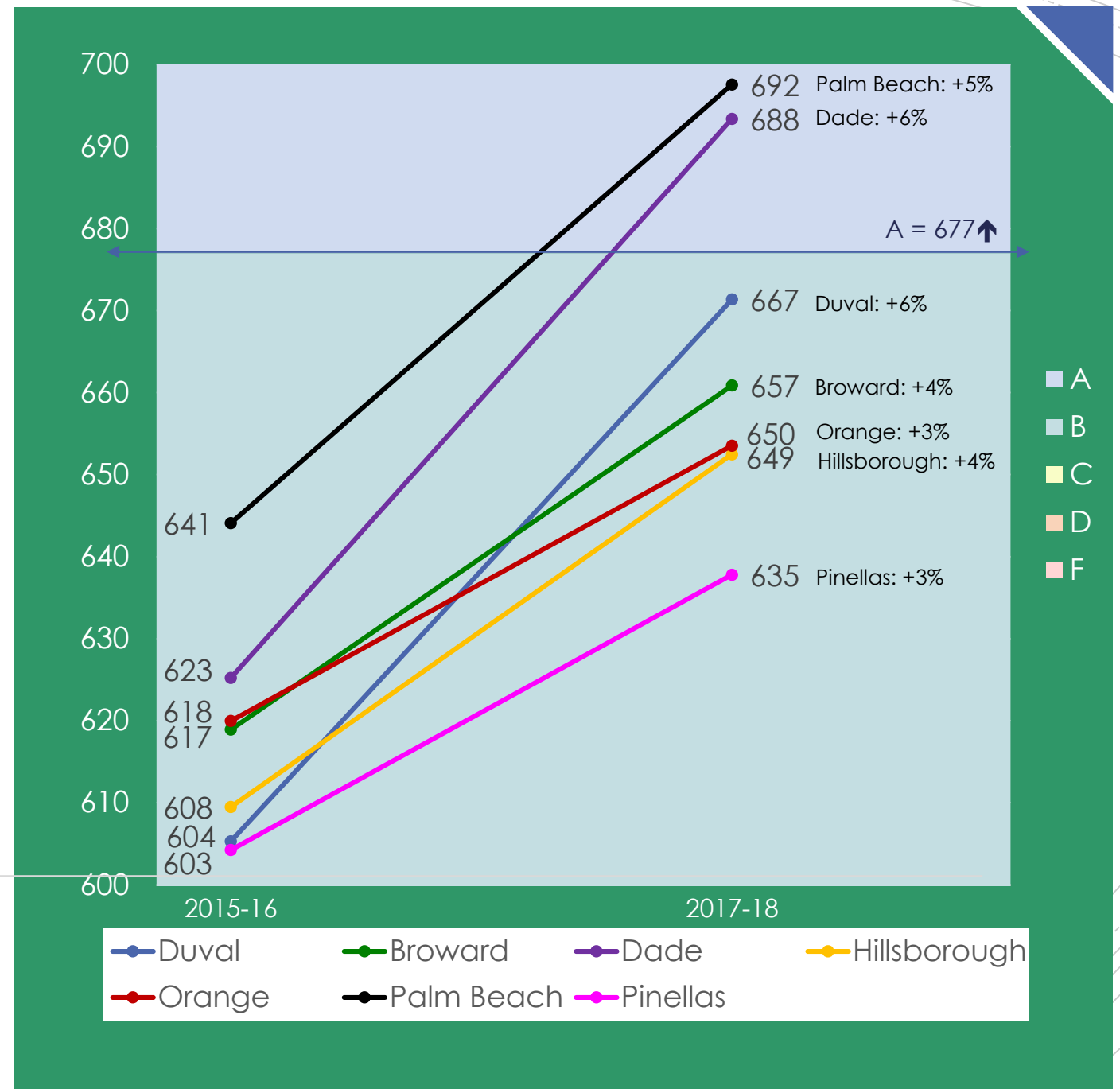

 F = 31 percent or less, 346 points or less



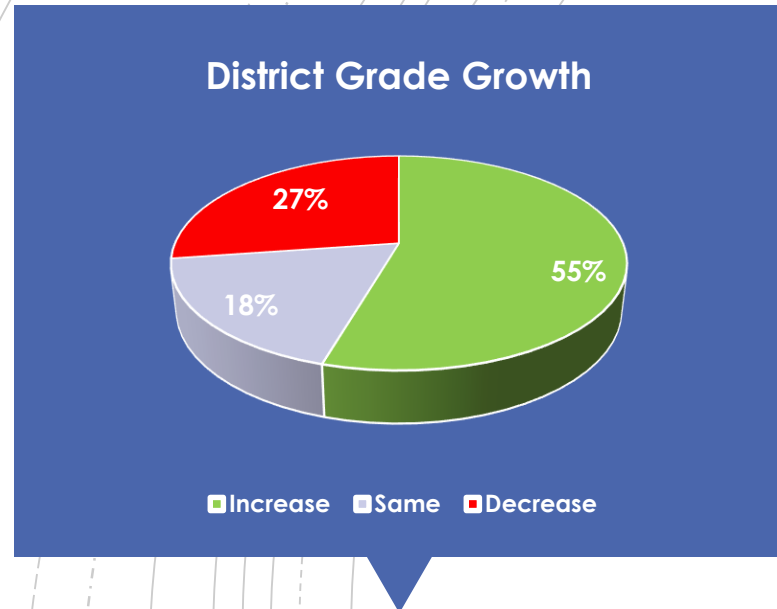

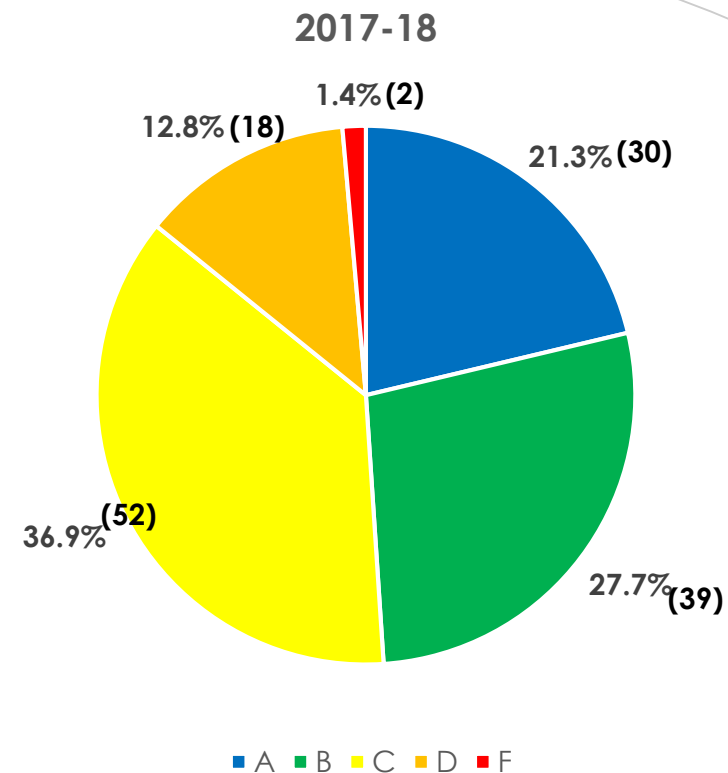
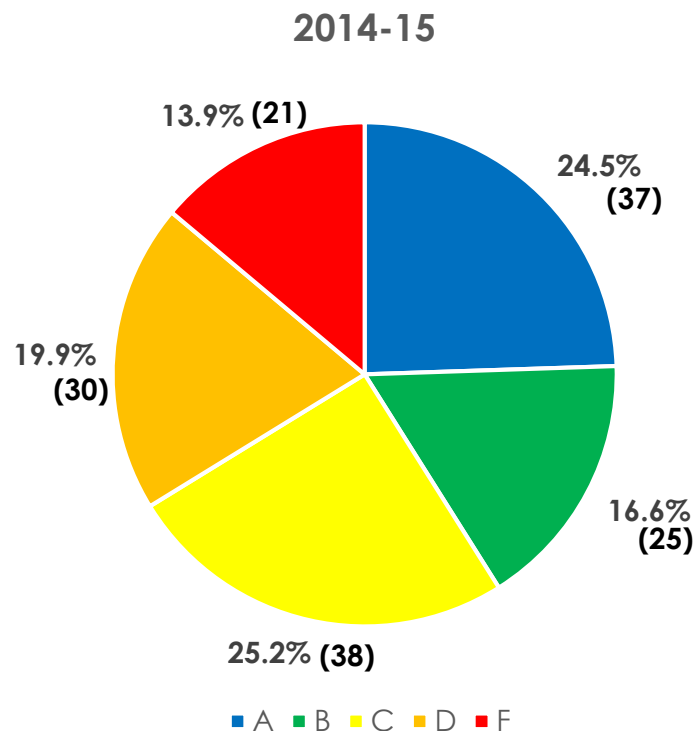

- While Duval County ranks 6th in the percent of A, B, and C schools, tied with Hillsborough, they have shown the **largest growth** in the percent of A, B, and C schools (23%) from 2014-15 to 2016-17.

Traditional School Grade Distribution



- The number of traditional schools receiving a school grade of F has decreased from 21 in 2014-15 to 2 in 2017-18.
- The number of traditional schools receiving a school grade of D has decreased from 30 in 2014-15 to 18 in 2017-18.

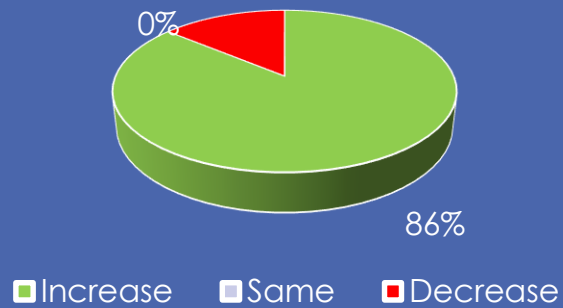

Growth in Percent Proficient for FSA ELA and Math Among Grade Bands between 2014-15 and 2017-18

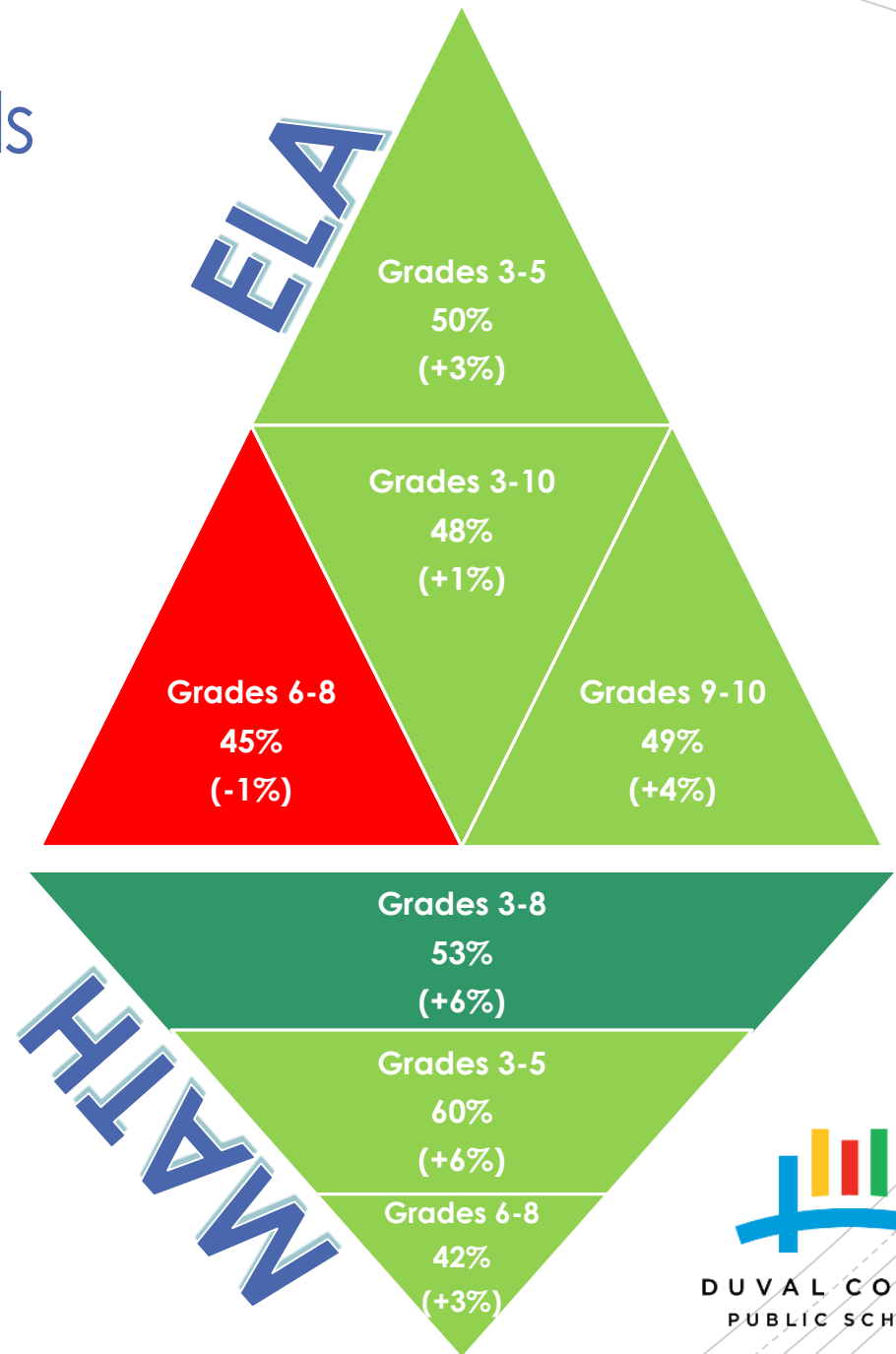
FSA ELA & Math by Grade Group
