In support of this Motion, the State would show as follows:

- 1. The Defendant was arrested for the charge of Leaving The Scene Of A Crash Involving Death. The State is in the process of filing an Information;
- 2. The Defendant bonded out after his January 28, 2019 arrest. As a condition of the Defendant's bond he was to refrain from consumption of alcohol, as well as refrain from driving.
