

Per a request for a limited date range of texts between myself and Joe Peppers, please see attached 2 sets of information.

Both sets are screengrabs taken from my personal cell phone. I pulled every text between myself and Mr. Peppers regardless of date and even though some are considered transitory and therefore not required as public records. Also, the second set are all texts from the same device that were exchanged with KHA Board Chair Kevin Gay. He was the only other person on the device with whom Mr. Peppers or KHA was mentioned.

There is one redaction that was created by the Office of General Counsel as it relates to health information of another person, so is not legally allowed to be released by me. In the remainder of the texts, there are some things deserving additional context:

In a few places, I have used less than perfect language during times of frustration. The frustrations were real and created by the inappropriate actions of others. Nevertheless, I am embarrassed to have used profanity and in hindsight wish I had been more thoughtful in my choice of words.

As has been noted, there were 2 sources of funding for the KHA micro-grants from the Summer and Fall 2018. The first batch were funded by reallocating \$50,000 from the Mayor's contingency fund.

In a text from January of this year there is mention of "the mayors faith based...." This reference demonstrates that 5 of the organizations were receiving funding from the Mayor's reallocated contingency funds.

In 3 texts from October 18, 2018, there is an exchange

1. Hughes: "Bethel gonna need micro"
2. Peppers: "Copy. Did they apply."
3. Hughes: "They Should"

This exchange demonstrates limitations caused by the brevity of text as a format. It was a communication reflecting that the deadline for the second set of applicants for micro-grants was the next day, and that I was encouraging KHA to make Bethel aware that they could apply for a micro-grant because they had an existing program for teenage boys that could be expanded if they were selected by the RFP process. There were no additional texts on this subject and, without taking the time to review the results, I am unaware if Bethel did apply or was selected.

These 2 sets are the only texts related to Joe Peppers, Kevin Gay or the micro-grants from my personal device. Any additional records from city devices and accounts will be provided through the City ITD/OGC process.
